

## Cayman National adopts roundabout

Representatives of the Cayman Islands Government and Cayman National Corporation signed an agreement giving Cayman National the responsibility of landscaping and maintaining the 'Elgin Avenue Roundabout' for the next five years. Cayman National Corporation has adopted the roundabout at the intersection of Annie Huldah Avenue, Elgin Avenue, and Thomas Russell Way.

For the next five years, the company has agreed to improve and maintain the aesthetic appearance of the areas inside the roundabout, as well as in the traffic islands running between lanes entering and exiting the intersection.

Representatives from the company signed an agreement finalising the arrangements with the National Roads Authority (NRA) and Ministry of Communications, Works and Infrastructure, on Thursday, 7 February.

Cayman National's Senior Executive for Corporate Communications, Claudia Welds, said, "The execution of this agreement demonstrates the continued commitment of Cayman National to good, corporate citizenship, and to building mutually beneficial relationships such as this one. We are excited to move forward with this project and look forward to creating a picturesque landscape for our community."

Welcoming the agreement and expressing appreciation to Cayman National, the Ministry's Chief Officer Carson Ebanks said, "The signing of the document is a continuation of government's on-going partnership with private sector organisations.

"Our aim is to encourage improvements in the horticultural and aesthetic appearance of certain locations on or near highways and on public roads across the islands."
